Dr. Christopher Harris is the Director of the School Library System for the Genesee Valley Educational Partnership, an educational services agency supporting the libraries of 22 small, rural districts in Western NY. A participant in the first American Library Association Emerging Leaders program in 2007, Christopher was honored as a Library Journal Mover and Shaker in 2008. Since then he has been involved with the ALA Office of Information Technology Policy (OITP) and ALA ebook and digital content efforts. Dr. Harris received his EdD from St. John Fisher College in 2018 for dissertation research on helping teachers become more confident teaching computer science. Christopher also has been working on a series of books on gaming and coding for Rosen Publishing. In addition to speaking on Friday afternoon, Christopher will be presenting a concurrent session and signing his books after Friday's General Session.

Exhibit Hall Grand Opening (Thursday)



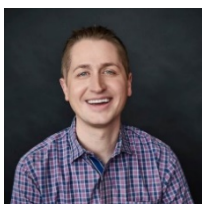
A ribbon cutting kicks off the conference with a festive spirit. Continental Breakfast will be served in the Exhibit Hall.
